European Championships 2013 for Youth up to 26

1. The organization of the European Championship Youth up to 26 has been allotted by the EDC to the Netherlands Draughts Federation.

The championship will be held on November, 03 - 09, 2013 (arriving day November 03th) at Texel, Holiday-centre De Krim, De Cocksdorp.

Travelling: From airport Amsterdam by train to Den Helder, by ferry to Texel, by bus to De Cocksdorp.

2. European Championship Youth up to 26 will be played:

- Boys players born 1st of January 1987 or younger.
- Girls players born 1st of January 1987 or younger.

- There are separate classifications for women and men.

3. Only members of European National Federations affiliated to the FMJD can participate. Players must have the citizenship of the Federation they represent or be members of this federation according to FMJD rules. EDC has the right to invite some players from new countries (never been members of FMJD).

4. There are no limits of number of players from one federation.

5. Applications (**only from national federations**) should be sent by e-mail <u>registration@europedraughts.org</u> and <u>joh.haijtink@planet.nl</u> before 1st of October and contain the list of players with full names, surnames, dates of birth. In case of any problems the national federation should contact EDC directly.

6. Time control 80' + 1' per move (Fisher system), Swiss system.

7. Final places are determined according to FMJD rules applying to corresponding tournaments system. Barrages should not be played. Only in the case of all criteria of challengers for champion's title will be an equal, barrage should be played (2 games with the time control 5' + 3" per move (Fisher system) and if champion will not be specified, then – games with time control 3' + 2" per move till the first winning). Details will be announced by a Chief Referee after the consultations with EDC official representative.

8. On the first day of the competition the Blitz Championship will be played (time control -5' + 3" per move (Fisher system).

- medals for the 3 first places
- cups for the winners
- In Blitz tournament:
- -medals for the 3 first places
- cups for the winners
- 10. Financial conditions
- Inscription fee is 20 euro for each player;
- Inscription fee in blitz championship is 10 euro for each player;
- Inscription fees has to be paid before the beginning of the Championship.
